Training on Public Information Act, Conflict of Interest, and Open Meetings Act

THSA Board Training

Public Information Act

- The THSA is covered under the Public Information Act (PIA), Texas Government Code Chapter 552
- Board members are required to have PIA training, please see <http://bit.ly/29g2ovy> for more information and links to the training video
- Under the PIA, information must be retained for a reasonable period of time; this is one of the reasons THSA has a records retention policy, which is available on the THSA's internet website

THSA Board Training

PIA Basics

- There is a process for responding to requests, including time lines and instructions for requesting that the information be kept confidential
- Determinations about whether exceptions apply in particular circumstances are made by the Office of the Texas Attorney General
- The THSA includes information about the PIA in all of its requests for proposals and similar releases to ensure third parties are aware of the Act and its application to the THSA; information is also provided on how to mark information as confidential
- Because of this process, it is **imperative that board members refer all requests for information to THSA staff** (i.e., if someone asks you for THSA documents, please don't handle the request yourself, but instead refer them to THSA staff)

PIA Exceptions

- There are a lot of exceptions – these are the ones we have used in the past and/or are more likely to use in the future:
 - Information made confidential under federal or state law or by judicial decision - for example, medical information that would be covered by HIPAA or the Texas Medical Records Privacy Act
 - Confidentiality of certain personnel information and certain personal information of public officials and employees (this is actually 2 exceptions)
 - Information relating to competition or bidding; also certain information submitted by potential vendor or contractor

THSA Board Training

PIA Exceptions Cont'd

- Information protected by attorney-client privilege
- Confidentiality of trade secrets and of certain commercial or financial information
 - Previously seen as applying only while the procurement was open; however,
 - A recent Texas Supreme Court decision broadly expanded a third party's right to keep certain information, most notably pricing information, from a contract with a public entity confidential
- Audit working papers
- Confidentiality of government information related to security or infrastructure of computers

THSA Board Training

Open Meetings Act

- The THSA is covered by the Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 551
- In general, the Open Meetings Act says that members of the Board who together would create a quorum for a meeting cannot discuss the THSA or THSA-related issues except at an open meeting – seven members of the full board or a majority of any committee membership make a quorum

- While the concept is sound, it can cause issues communicating between board meetings – **“reply all” on an email from a THSA staffer or board member to an email with multiple board members should be avoided**

THSA Board Training

Open Meetings Act Exceptions

- There are a number of exceptions to the open meeting requirements
- However, a closed meeting can only be called during an open meeting and the exception being used must be stated
- The exceptions include:
 - Consultation with an attorney
 - Deliberations about real property or the acceptance of a gift or donation
 - Personnel matters
 - Issues relating to security audits or devices
 - Deliberation of economic development negotiations
- During investigations, a witness may be excluded from an open meeting during testimony from other witnesses on the same issue

THSA Board Training

Conflict of Interest

- Section 182.056, Health & Safety Code states:
 - (b) Any board member or member of a committee formed by the board with direct interest in a matter, personally or through an employer, before the board **shall abstain from deliberations and actions on the matter** in which the conflict of interest arises and **shall further abstain on any vote on the matter, and may not otherwise participate in a decision on the matter.**
 - (c) Each board member shall **file a conflict of interest statement** and a statement of ownership interests with the board to ensure disclosure of all existing and potential personal interests related to board business.

THSA Board Training

Conflict of Interest

- THSA has a conflict of interest policy that the board updated at our last meeting
- This policy addresses multiple subjects regarding conflicts of interest:
 - **Purpose**
 - **Definitions**
 - Conflict of interest, Familial relationship, HIE, Interest, Interested Person, Key employee, Transaction
 - **Procedures**
 - Duty to disclose, board meeting, determining whether a conflict of interest exists, procedures for addressing the conflict of interest, violations of conflicts of interest policy
 - **Presumed conflicts of interest**
 - Employees and/or board members of HIEs other than HIETexas/THSA
 - Interested parties with a familial relationship with a THSA employee
 - Representative of a party other than HIETexas/THSA in a transaction
 - Duty to disclose
 - Violations of the conflicts of interest policy relating to presumed conflicts of interest

THSA Board Training

Conflict of Interest

- THSA has a conflict of interest policy that the board updated at our last meeting
- This policy addresses multiple subjects regarding conflicts of interest (continued):
 - **Records of proceedings**
 - **Compensation**
 - **Annual Statements**
 - **Periodic reviews**
 - **Use of outside experts**

THSA Board Training

Conflict of Interest

- The board's listed interests are located in **Attachment No. 6 (pdf page 023)** in your attachments document
- If at any point during a board meeting, a board member believes that their own interest (disclosed or not) in a matter before the board may lead to a conflict of interest, please refrain from deliberations on the matter, and please refrain from voting on the matter
- If at any point during a board meeting, a board member believes that another board member's interest in a matter may lead to a conflict of interest on a matter before the board, please state such, so that the board may further discuss whether such a conflict of interest does exist for that member, and how to best handle the situation moving forward







EDEN DATA FLOW HIE CONNECTIVITY PROJECT

The data flow graphic on the right shows how data flows under the Texas HIE Connectivity Project



HOW EDEN WORKS



Data Sources (Hospitals, SNFs, and others) send real-time admit and discharge data to EDEN.

EDEN receives data both directly from hospitals and local HIEs.

EDEN compares patient info between ADTs and patient lists and, if a match occurs, sends alerts to appropriate subscribers.


Messages received from data sources are purged after transmission. The only data retained are the subscriber lists.

Subscribers (with patient consent) provide a list of patients on whom they wish to receive notifications. Lists are regularly refreshed.


EDEN serves as a single, standardized access point for authorized subscribers to receive alerts in a statewide capacity.




ADDITIONAL CLINICAL DATA

- EDEN can also automate queries to retrieve clinical documents (discharge summaries, etc.) and route those to EDEN subscribers as well.
- Leverages national exchange networks such as eHealth Exchange, Carequality, and Commonwell
- Provides EDEN subscribers with additional insights into encounter details:
 - Vitals
 - Medications
 - Labs
 - Procedures



UPDATE AND CONSIDERATION OF THSA'S PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS

HIETexas PULSE IN THE NEWS!

- On September 6th, 2021, THSA, in partnership with Audacious Inquiry and BCFS, deployed HIETexas PULSE in Louisiana in response to Hurricane Ida.
- The purpose of the deployment was to (1) help out a neighboring state, and (2) validate HIETexas PULSE would work in an emergency medical care shelter environment.

HIETexas Service	Status
Patient Unified Lookup System for Emergencies (PULSE)	Fully Operational

- **Current status:**
 - Live and available for immediate use during declared disasters
 - Administrator and end-user training videos and materials now available on THSA's new website
 - THSA has provided input into the Ai product roadmap based on production use for Hurricane Ida
- **Next steps:**
 - Exploring expanded base of additional end user organizations
 - Working on next upgrade, focus on user interface enhancements, largely based on field deployment in response to hurricane Ida in the New Orleans area of Louisiana

CURRENT STATUS OF HIETexas PULSE

- HIETexas PULSE Texas disaster response medical shelter organization updates:
 - Recent accomplishments:
 - Actual production use for disaster response
 - Completed process integration (for PULSE deployment lifecycle) for admins and clinical end users
 - Next steps:
 - Validate and improve process integration (between THSA and PULSE client organizations)
 - Collaborate on lessons learned in advance of 2022 hurricane season



UPDATE AND CONSIDERATION OF THSA'S PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS CURRENT STATUS OF STAR HIE PROGRAM – SANER PROJECT

Problem Statement – Underlying Award

- The process by which hospitals transmit capacity (e.g., space, staff, supplies) and capability (e.g., available specialty care) data to public health authorities and emergency response personnel **lacks a standard data language** and common framework for exchange.
- This can lead to an **incomplete understanding** of a given region's acute care capacity and capability.
- The current data submission process can be **time/resource intensive** for hospital staff.

UPDATE AND CONSIDERATION OF THSA'S PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS CURRENT STATUS OF STAR HIE PROGRAM – SANER PROJECT

Vision Statement – Underlying Award

- Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resources (FHIR) can be used as a **common standard for hospitals** and health systems to share select information.
- Data can be **extracted automatically** and in **real-time** from underlying data systems at both the hospital and regional HIE level.
- Data can then be **leveraged by multiple local, state and federal agencies** for dashboards, reports and analytics.

UPDATE AND CONSIDERATION OF THSA'S PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS CURRENT STATUS OF STAR HIE PROGRAM – SANER PROJECT

Immunization Data – Supplemental Award

- The STAR HIE Cooperative Agreement recently expanded to **“improve COVID-19 vaccination data by connecting immunization information systems (IISs) to Health Information Exchanges (HIEs).** The funding seeks to better align HIEs with public health and leverage the extensive amount of clinical data held by HIEs to support enhanced knowledge sharing around the COVID-19 vaccinations.”
- “Services or functionalities will be deployed to enable, enhance or increase the use of health information exchange among relevant entities, including providers who care for vulnerable or at-risk populations. Such services and functions will need to address communities disproportionately impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, including as it relates to the stratifying factors of age, race, ethnicity and sex.

CURRENT STATUS OF STAR HIE PROGRAM – SANER PROJECT

HIETexas Service	Status
STAR HIE Program – Situational Awareness for Novel Epidemic Response (SANER) Project	PILOT

- **Current status:**
 - Completed RFP for FHIR-based Application Software Development Services – Lantana Consulting Group
 - We now have two pilot hospitals – Knox County and Parkland Memorial
 - Working with DSHS/ONC/other HIEs on next steps regarding supplemental award and vaccination data
- **Next steps:**
 - Now that we have all parties in place, we're beginning technical implementation
 - Begin technical implementation under supplemental award

UPDATE AND CONSIDERATION OF THSA'S PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS

CURRENT STATUS OF SECURETexas CERTIFICATION

- The THSA offers a voluntary privacy and security certification program, known as “SECURETexas Certification,” that measures a Texas covered entity’s past compliance with state and federal medical privacy and security law.
- If a covered entity possesses SECURETexas Certification at the time of an alleged violation of the Texas Medical Records Privacy Act, the covered entity may present the certification as evidence to be taken into consideration as a mitigating factor in developing administrative or civil monetary penalties.
- Staff monitored legislation that may affect SECURETexas Certification during the 87th Texas Legislative Session.
