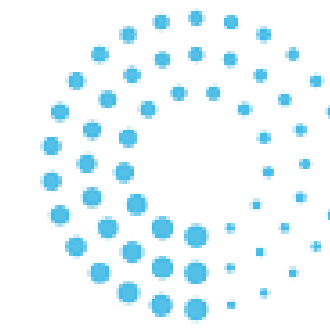

Health Information Jobs Outlook



HIMSS™

- Employment of medical records and health information **specialists** is projected to grow 8 percent from 2022 to 2032, faster than average for all occupations
 - 2023 Median Pay = \$48,780 (\$23.45/hour)
- Employment of medical and health services **managers** is projected to grow 28 percent from 2022 to 2032, much faster than the average for all occupations
 - 2023 Median Pay = \$110,680 (\$53.21/hour)
- The demand for health services is expected to increase as the population ages

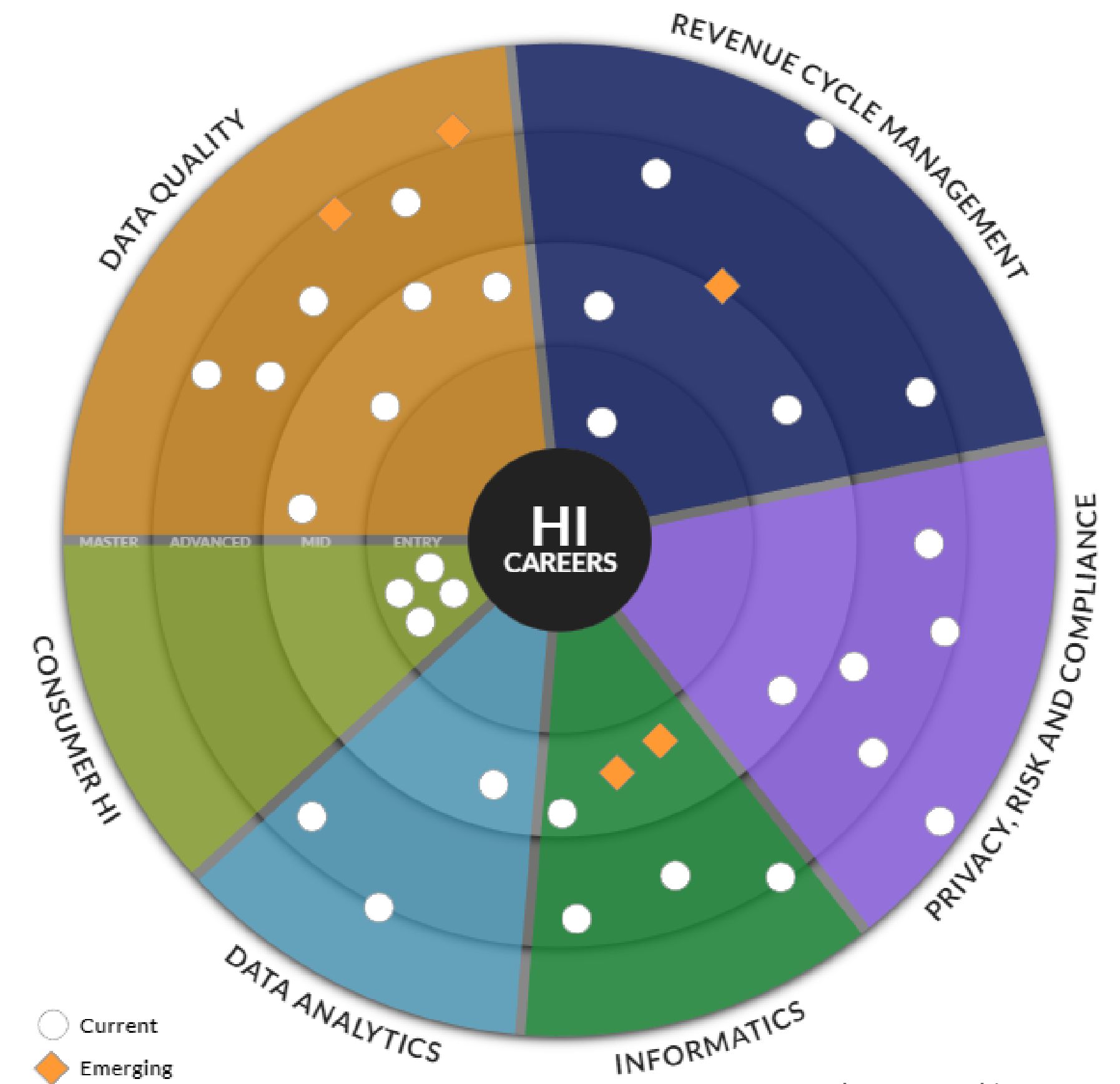

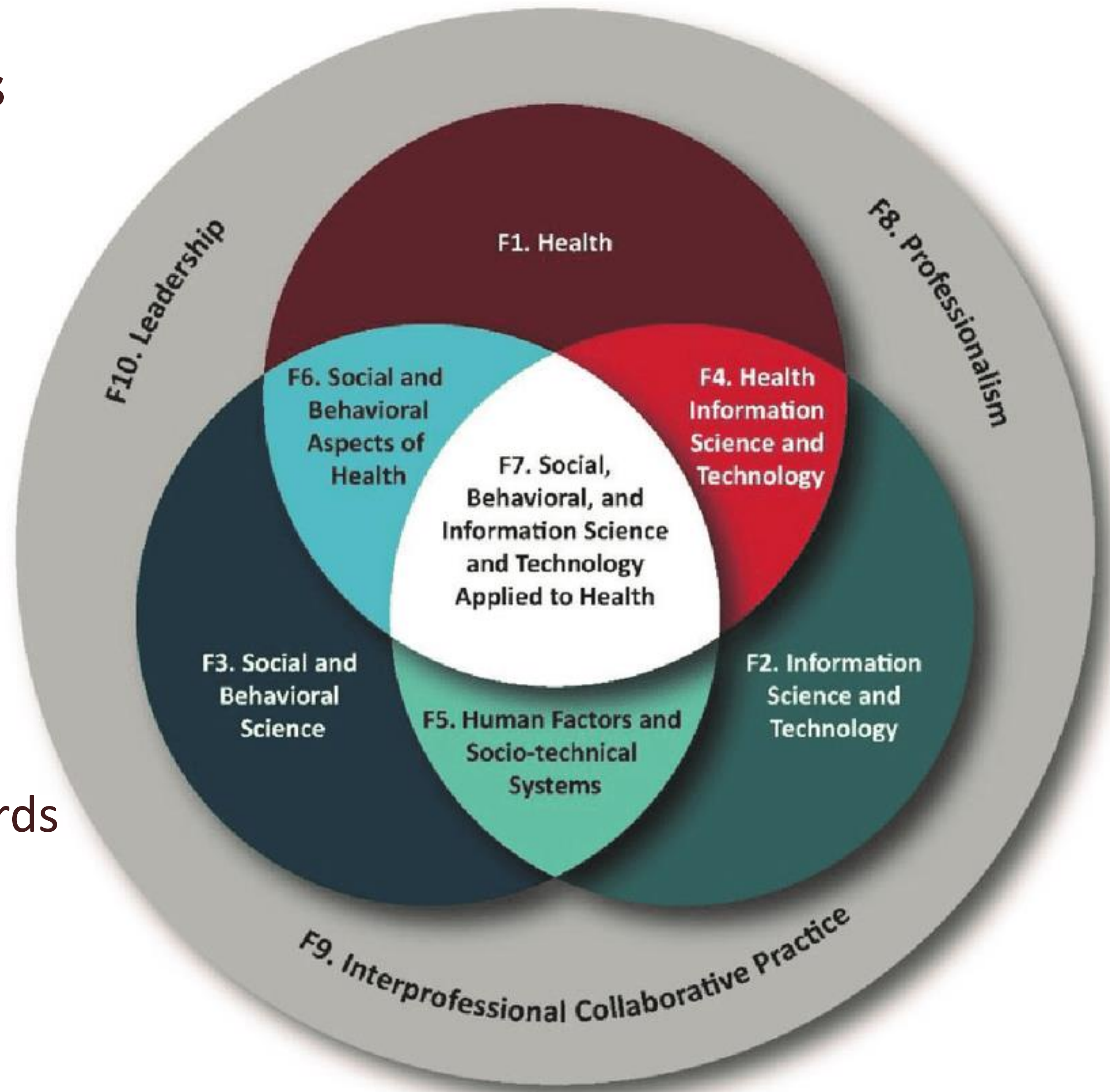


Health Informatics Domains

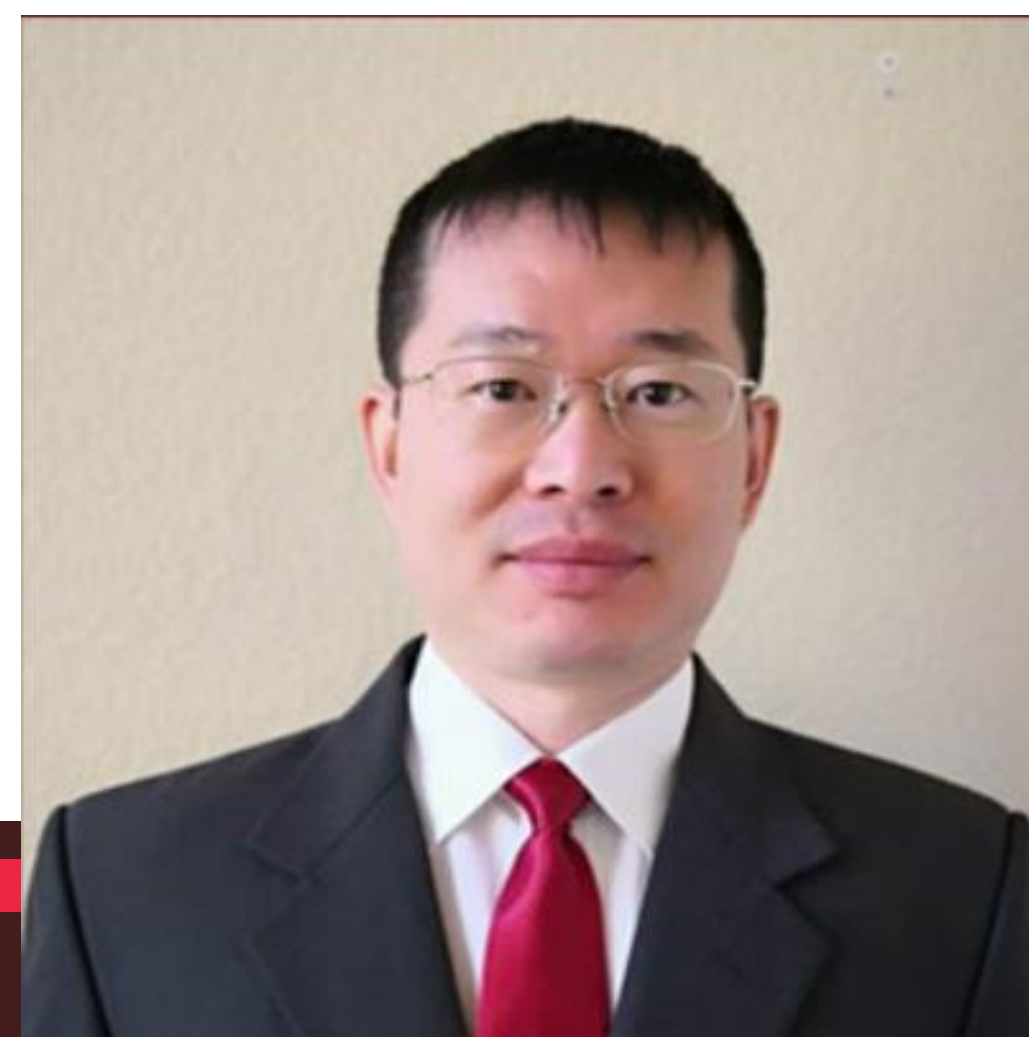

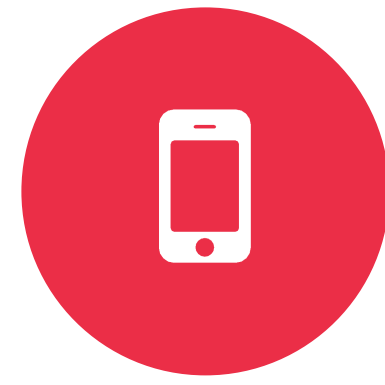
